

THE CHRYSOSTOM SCHOLARSHIP TERMS AND CONDITIONS

These terms and conditions are the rules under which the Chrysostom Scholarship is awarded by Hellenic College, Inc. ("HC").

What is the Chrysostom Scholarship? The Chrysostom Scholarship (the "Scholarship") provides financial assistance to HC students who receive a Scholarship under these terms and conditions. Those students who are awarded the Scholarship will receive 100% of the cost of first year undergraduate tuition, and 80% of the cost of each subsequent undergraduate year at HC, as long as these terms and conditions are met. The total value of the Scholarship is up to \$68,000 per awardee. Please note that the Scholarship does not cover any other costs, so awardees will need to make other arrangements to pay for room and board, fees, books, insurance and other expenses.

Who is eligible to apply? Each first place finisher of the Chrysostom Oratorical Festival at the Parish level is eligible to apply. However, in the event that the first place finisher chooses not to apply or is not eligible under these terms and conditions, then the second place finisher of that Parish's Oratorical Festival is encouraged to apply. Similarly, in the event that the first place finisher and the second place finisher choose not to apply or are not eligible under these terms and conditions, then the third place finisher of that Parish's Oratorical Festival is encouraged to apply. In the event of a tie, the Parish Chrysostom Committee shall decide eligibility. If none of the top three finishers of a Parish are willing or able to obtain the Scholarship, then that year's Scholarship will be forfeited.

What if the first, second or third place finishers are not seniors in high school? Then HC will gladly preserve their eligibility to apply (as it is described above) until it is time for them to attend HC.

What are the requirements of the Scholarship? In order to be awarded and maintain the Scholarship, each awardee must:

- Be admitted as a full-time undergraduate student at HC through the normal admissions process and at all times remain in good standing.
- At all times comply with HC Student Handbook and other rules, as they may be amended from time to time by HC.
- Starting with the second year at HC, maintain at least a 3.0 GPA each semester on a 4.0 scale.

What are the procedures for Parishes, Metropolis Chairpersons and students? Each Parish Chrysostom Committee shall provide the Metropolis Chairperson a written list of the top three finishers, their respective scores and contact information. The Metropolis Chairperson shall forward that information to HC's admissions department (adesses@hchc.edu) by March 15. The students are then encouraged to apply to be admitted as HC students online at www.hchc.edu, and contact the Admissions Department at 617-850-1260 to apply for the Scholarship.

What are the other Terms and Conditions?

- Scholarships are contingent on the availability of funds.
- These terms and conditions may be amended from time to time by HC in its sole discretion.
- In the event of a conflict between these terms and conditions and any other statements, written or oral regarding the Scholarship, then these terms and conditions will control.
- These terms and conditions only represent an invitation for first, second and third place finishers (as applicable) of the Parish level Chrysostom Oratorical Festival to apply for the Scholarship. No one is entitled to a Scholarship based on the outcome of an Oratorical Festival alone.
- All Scholarship awards shall be made by HC in its subjective discretion and in accordance with these terms and conditions.
